Sentences Without Adverbs	Sentences Elaborated with Adverbs
The invitation arrived.	The invitation arrived today .
The party will take place.	The party will take place inside .
We will dress for playing games.	We will dress casually for playing games.

Elaborating Sentences Add adverbs that tell *when*, *where*, or *how* to elaborate each sentence.

Example: We are going to a party.

Today we are going to a party.
