We received a check for **\$499.40** this week for all of our box tops!!!! Thank you for taking the time to clip them and send them to us. These funds go into our technology budget.

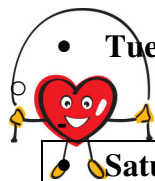


CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK:
