
Dear Families.



And we stand in solidarity with the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem, Cardinal Pierbattista Pizzaballa, and all the Ordinaries of the Holy Land in calling for a day of fasting, abstinence, and prayer on Tuesday, October 17, for all those who have been and will be harmed by the violence, and for a just and lasting peace. On Tuesday, October 10th, Marie Zweber came and talked to our students about how important life is and how God loves each of us from conception to death. She shared that sometimes women who are expecting a child, instead of being filled with joy, are scared. She showed videos of an ultrasound of an infant only 8 weeks old and also handed out a "frozen pea" to each student. This pea served as a visual aid showing that a baby's heart starts beating when they are smaller than the pea they were holding. Marie used to work at "Options for Women." Options for Women offers a safe, confidential place for expectant mothers to talk to someone about their situation and for support throughout their pregnancy, so they need not be scared. Because their services are free of charge, we are facilitating a "baby bottle" drive for a month to help support their cause.
