Dear families:

Pope Francis said, "Advent is a time to let go of the worldly distractions that take us away from God, and focus on growing closer to him through prayer and concern for others." Advent wreaths are a favorite way to celebrate the month of December leading up to Christmas Day. Many are not aware of the rich meaning and symbolism embedded in the tradition. SHAPE: The circular shape of the wreath, without beginning or end, symbolizes God's complete and unending love for us. **NUMBER**: Four candles which are lit, one at a time, on each of the four Sundays of the Advent season. Some traditions also include a fifth white "Christ" candle, symbolizing purity that is lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas day. **COLOR:** Violet is a liturgical color that is used to signify a time of prayer, penance, and sacrifice and is used during Advent and Lent. **WEEKS**: The 1st Sunday of Advent symbolizes **Hope** with the "Prophet's Candle" reminding us that Jesus is coming. • The 2nd Sunday of Advent symbolizes Faith with the "Bethlehem Candle" reminding us of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. We pray that amidst the busy pace of the life, you find Hope and Faith this Advent Season.
