Dear Families,

Create in Me a Clean Heart is a Responsorial Psalm that we sing during the Lenten season, this year beginning March 6<sup>th</sup>. This is also the title of the Bishops of Untied States response to what is now being called **a public health crisis of the digital age** – pornography. Now I know this is not a typical subject for my newsletters, however I feel the need to pass on what I have learned over this past month. One or two clicks on a Smartphone, tablet or computer allows anyone to be exposed to or view sexually explicit images and/or engage in activities that he or she would hesitate to do off-line. There are alarming statistics for you to be aware of. In 2016, a study by the Barna Group discovered **among teens age 13-17** 

- 21% came across porn weekly; 18% sought it out weekly.
- In total, 57% of teens sought out porn at least monthly.
- Nearly 27% of teens receive sexts and around 15% are sending them!

Sunday March 10<sup>th</sup> is being deemed *Safe Haven Sunday*. It is a day set aside to build awareness and ask Parents and Guardians to be vigilant about the technology that is allowed into their homes. Our Tri-Parishes will have information provided in the back of church starting March 10<sup>th</sup> to help aide parents in this crisis. There are also links available to many websites on our tri-parish website <a href="www.catholictriparish.org/parent-resources.html">www.catholictriparish.org/parent-resources.html</a> under the Resources page. *Covenant Eyes* is an example; it monitors and keeps a record of all your Internet browsing. They will even <a href="block the bad stuff">block the bad stuff</a> if you want. Besides educating yourself of this peril, continue to foster openness and trust with your children so they know that they can come to you if they see an image not meant for their eyes. Pray for protection and as our 4K sing at their graduation "*Oh*, be careful little eyes what you see!"


