- 2. **Keep God First.**, we urge you to watch Mass with Father Emmanuel, every day at 10:00 a.m., look on our webpage <a href="https://www.catholictriparish.org">https://www.catholictriparish.org</a> and click on Live Mass. Palm Sunday at 11:30AM, 7:00PM Holy Thursday Mass, 1:00PM Good Friday service, 7:00PM Easter Vigil, and 11:30AM Easter Sunday Mass.
- 3. **Holy Communion**: The best way to receive Christ is in Holy Communion at Mass. Yet for those times you can't make Mass (like now) you can still reach out to Him by making a Spiritual Communion in prayer! Father Emmanuel references it in all of His online Masses, here is the prayer:

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament.

I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine! (3x)

- 4. St. Mary's and Holy Rosary Churches will be open daily from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
  - Maybe you can find time as a family to just sit with the Lord, pray and feel comforted.
- 5. **FORMED** it's been called NetFlix for Catholics. In an effort to assist they are opening their doors to make the FORMED platform free to everyone for the next 40 days. "Sign up today and get immediate access to the best Catholic movies, faith formation videos, audio talks, and great children's videos". As we are gathered together in our homes, this can be a tremendous opportunity to watch something as a family that will inspire hope and remind us all that the Lord will provide for us even through these difficult times.

### **Academics:**

- 1. Student learning will continue as directed by their teachers. This will continue until, as of today, through April 24. Weekly drop off/ pick up times will be on **Tuesdays** (except Holy Week) and reminders, along with expectations, will be emailed and posted each week as well on our webpage <a href="https://www.catholictriparish.org/acs-homework">https://www.catholictriparish.org/acs-homework</a>.
- 2. Families can drop off and pick up their child's work on the following dates and times:

  - Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup> from 3:00- 5:30
- **3. Attendance**: To establish a consistent manner to account for a present or not present student, attendance will be based through the students' daily work. When teachers are assigning work, it is gauged on recommendations of what constitutes a day's worth of assigned work. **So it is important that you hand all items due on its scheduled due date.**

- 5. Reports cards will be mailed on **Friday**, **April 3**.
