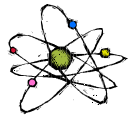

## **“MURDER ON THE MENU”**


This year's 8<sup>th</sup> grade play is a mix of comedy with a good mystery in this dinner theatre style show.
