

Dear Families:

He has Risen, He has Risen indeed!!! This is an important greeting to use the next 44 days (until Pentecost) to remind and encourage us to continue to live in the light of Jesus' victory over death every day of the year. The Resurrection of Jesus changed everything! Reading several reflections about the importance of the Resurrection, here is a brief summary of 5 "takeaways".

- 1. We Are Loved The cross of Christ leaves no room for doubt about God's love for us.
- 2. We're Not Alone Jesus knows our pain (Isaiah 53:3) and He is with us to help us through it.
- 3. We Can Rest In a time of increasing exhaustion, constant stress, and weariness, Jesus offers us rest.
- 4. We Can Be Hopeful He is risen is a declaration of hope. It means death doesn't have the final word.
- 5. We Can Keep Going When you just want to give up we can keep going because Jesus keeps us going.

VIRTUE OF THE WEEK:



Moderation was our virtue we highlighted before Easter Break. It means giving attention to balance in one's life. We prayed, Jesus, help me to practice the virtue of moderation today so that I have enough time to spend with You in prayer. Our virtue this week was modesty. Modesty is our purity of heart in action. Modesty

means not attracting attention to ourselves in other ways. In silent prayer, we prayed:

Dear Jesus, I want to live my life seeking Your love, not the praise of others.
