Dear Families,

This week at Mass, Father Emmanuel taught us Pope Francis 5 finger prayer. Each digit on your hand represents people you should pray for:

- 1. **Thumb** (finger closest to your heart) Pray for those closest to your heart
- 2. Index (pointer)finger— (finger used to correct or point things out) Pray for those who instruct you
- 3. **Middle finger** (the tallest finger- for other fingers to "look up to") Pray for our leaders
- 4. **Ring finger** (our weakest finger) Pray for the weak and poor
- 5. **Pinkie finger** (the smallest finger last in line) Pray for yourself and your own needs.

Talk to your children about this and challenge them, and yourselves, to incorporate it into daily prayer life....
