Dear Families.

Tuesday, at Mass, we celebrated the Feast of Saint Matthew, Apostle and evangelist. If you don't know a lot about St. Matthew, he was a tax collector and hung out with "those known as sinners". When the Pharisees saw Jesus dining with Matthew and other "unworthy" people, they were shocked. What business did the supposedly great teacher have associating with such immoral people? Jesus' answer was, "*Those who are well do not need a physician, but the sick do.*" "*I did not come to call the righteous but sinners*" (Matthew 9:12b-13).
