Dear Families,

The month of October is traditionally dedicated to Our Blessed Mother Mary under her title, "*Our Lady of the Rosary*." Pope Gregory XIII named this feast because Christians, after praying the Rosary, won a critical victory at the naval Battle of Lepanto.

According to Franciscan Media, the development of the rosary has a long history. First, a practice developed of praying 150 Our Fathers in imitation of the 150 Psalms. Then there was a parallel practice of praying 150 Hail Marys. Soon a mystery of Jesus' life was attached to each Hail Mary. The purpose of the rosary is to help us meditate on the great mysteries of our salvation. The main focus is on Jesus—his **birth** (Joyful Mysteries), **life** (Luminous Mysteries), **death** (Sorrowful Mysteries) and **resurrection** (Glorious Mysteries) *The Our Father prayer* reminds us that Jesus' Father is the author of salvation. *The Hail Mary prayer* reminds us to join with Mary in contemplating these mysteries and also make us aware that Mary was, and is, closely joined with her Son in all the mysteries of His earthly and heavenly existence. *The Glory Be* prayer reminds us that **the purpose of all life is the glory of the Trinity.** 

The rosary appeals to many people. It is simple and the constant repetition of words helps create an atmosphere that allows us to reflect on the mysteries of Jesus. Our faith tells us Jesus and Mary are with us in our own joys and sorrows of life.
