New Business

Pink Box Purpose Purse Bingo- to help further the mission in the Honduras, St Mary's will hold a **Tri-Parish** bingo on a Wednesday evening (TBA). All women will be invited and everyone will win a purse by the end of the evening. Refreshments will also be provided.

Donations for India (Father Bosco) Father Bosco spoke about his "parishes" in India and need for food, clothing, medical, and educational supplies for families and children. All PCCW members present voted to give Father Bosco \$1200.

J. Kothbauer stated that the price of fish has increased. It was suggested that the price of a fish dinner would be \$12. We would also only offer one size dinner to make the process more efficient.
