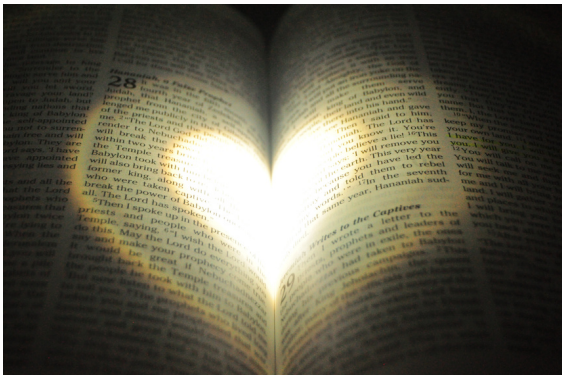


## WHO WE ARE

- **Seven Sisters Apostolate**: Fourteen women from the Tri-Parishes devote an hour of prayer weekly on an assigned day for the sanctity and special intentions of Parish priests.
- Sponsor a child's education in the **For One Child of India** program.
- Present **sacramental gifts** for Baptisms, First Communion, Confirmation and graduating seniors.
- Sponsor **Masses** as Christmas and Easter gifts for the intentions of parish "shut-ins" who live in their own homes, in nursing homes and assisted living facilities.
- Serve **funeral luncheons**.
- Participate in the community **Sharing Table** program along with Zion Lutheran and Central Lutheran churches.
- Prepare and serve 2 or 3 **Lion's Club meeting dinners** each year.
- **Frame pictures** of outgoing priests and deacons.
- Offer a **Spirituality Morning** during or before Lent or Advent
