

Sacred Heart PCCW Meeting Monday, July 5, 2021 – 5:45 p.m.

5:45 Holy Rosary recited in church

Refreshments served by St. Marie's Group.

Kathy Herfel called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm, with prayer by Father Emmanuel.

Roll Call was done by secretary, Rose Sabelko. In attendance were:

Secretary's Report. Minutes from the May 3rd meeting were reviewed. Correction was noted of last name for a prayer shawl was given to Jim "Towle".

Treasurer's Report. Marilynn Sheahan gave the treasurer's report from May 3, 2021 through July 5, 2021. Income was \$1,639.03, expenses \$1,517.31, with a balance of \$11,794.99. There were no additions or corrections to the report. The report will be filed for audit. Marilynn also noted a check had still not been issued to Abbey Fedie for the 2020 scholarship. Marilynn will follow up on this with Abbey.

- Service – Glenda. Nothing specific at this time.

Sunshine report: Glenda reported that a welcome basket and mum plant was given to Benjamin & Josephine Mitchell. Benjamin is our new Tri-Parish Coordinator of Evangelization and Faith Formation. He and Josephine recently moved into a home in Mondovi. A prayer shawl was given to Wanda's sister, who lost her husband. Wanda reported that the graduation gifts have arrived.

Old and New Business, Correspondence, Announcements:

Correspondence/Thank You's—Marilynn had read a "Thank You" note from the family of Robert Weiss which had included a check with an extra \$100 for the funeral lunch.

Scholarships were presented to Ella Poeschel from the PCCW and Hailey Bauer from the Knights of Columbus. Both scholarships were for the amount of \$500.00.

Reception for Father Timothy. It was noted that Father Timothy Reither would be presiding over his first Mass, this weekend, at Sacred Heart. Wanda and Glenda have prepared the menu and will purchase items and get workers to help with a reception this coming Sunday.

Ladies Night Out is scheduled for the second Monday in November (November 8th) at Sacred Heart. Members who coordinate this event were not present at tonight's meeting, so it was tabled until next meeting.

Kathy discussed tentative plans for a **"Spirituality morning in October"**. Clara Ruff would be the speaker for the event which would run from 8:00 a.m. until 12/Noon. Kathy will look at more dates

Habitat for Humanity Meals. Glenda reported that Laura Sandberg inquired whether our PCCW would furnish meals for workers at the Habitat house being built in Mondovi. Glenda will prepare the menu and find workers.

Funeral Lunch Charges. Glenda reported that a funeral for Lois Havenor is scheduled for August 21st. The funeral home had suggested \$3.00/plate to serve the meal.

Lions Club Dinners Charges. Glenda reported that current price per dinner is \$8.50 with a guarantee of 30 dinners. A fee of \$10/plate was suggested to the Lion's Club, but a final decision was tabled. The Lion's Club will meet again in September.

Benjamin, our new **Tri-Parish Coordinator of Evangelization and Faith Formation**, and his wife, Josephine, were unable to attend the meeting. Will arrange for another time.

Seven Sisters Apostolate. Kathy stated that currently there are 7 parishioners who each have a day of the week that they pray for our pastor, Father Emmanuel. With the addition of Father Reither, it is necessary to have more volunteers for a day with one hour of prayer dedicated to Father Reither. Rose volunteered for each Wednesday. Kathy will continue looking for more volunteers.

Rose-Colored Altar Cloth. Marilyn reported they found the correct rose color for altar cloth. This will be ordered through the Stempers catalogue.

Tri-Parish News. Father Emmanuel encouraged members of the PCCW to follow FORMED, an online program that will enrich our Catholic lives and to promote evangelization. Adoration will resume in the Tri-Parish with St. Mary's having 40-hour devotion during Advent and Sacred Heart having 40-hour devotion in Lent. Holy Rosary will have the 24-hour adoration every second Thursday of the month. Mass of the Anointing will be scheduled for the week before Christmas. This will include home visits.

Father Emmanuel stated that with the arrival of Father Timothy Reither, consideration has been given to adding two weekend Masses. A 6:30 Saturday evening Mass will be added at Sacred Heart – Mondovi, and a 9:00 Mass will be added at St. Mary's – Durand.

Other:

Donation of \$200.00 to Sacred Heart Cemetery as approved in March of 2020. Recent landscaping was completed around the cemetery altar. Previously Glen and Bernice Fedie had generously donated funds to have the paved drive through the cemetery. Efforts are being made to clean-up the cemetery grounds. It was noted that an interruption of follow-up meetings, due to the Covid pandemic, that the check had not been issued to the Cemetery committee. A check will be sent to Gary Sabelko, Sextant for Sacred Heart Cemetery.

Per the March meeting, the need for a new photocopier was discussed. The photocopier located in multi-media room (formerly bride's room) was received from Holy Rosary (Assumption School). It had been purchased by the Holy Rosary PCCW, but was no longer needed due to a new contract for equipment for the schools. The copier was sitting idle and Margot arranged for the large copier to be brought to Sacred Heart. Father Emmanuel noted Sacred Heart will continue using this copier.

Also, per March meeting, a vote carried to purchase a Mass Kit for Sacred Heart to be used at Masses at the Lutheran Home/Assisted Living and the Home Place. A donation was received from a resident at the Senior Assisted Living to cover the cost of the Mass Kit. Sacred Heart PCCW will have a plate engraved by Diane Hansen to acknowledge the donation. Suggested engraving: In Memory and Honor of Bill and Marie Gruber. We will defer to Diane for correct verbage.

Funeral Lunch. St. Rose group will serve lunch for the August meeting.

Closing. Wanda gave a closing reading entitled "Talk to Him".
