Secretary's Report. Minutes from July 5, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Becky Williamson made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Judy Woodworth. Approved.

Treasurer's Report. Marilyn Sheahan gave the treasurer's report from July 5, 2021 to August 30, 2021. Income was \$1,790.40 and expenses were \$1,584.59, leaving a balance of \$12,000.80. There were no additions or corrections to the report and it will be filed for audit.

- Service – Anne Fath is new Service Commission leader and talked about Joshua's Camp.

Some discussion was had on what the commissions, Spirituality, Leadership and Service mean and how they are beneficial to our PCCW.
