

## St. Mary's PCCW Meeting Minutes

The meeting called to order at 6:03 by Tiffany Garner, who lead us in a special prayer.

**Roll call:** There were 14 women present. All groups were represented, except for St Catherine and St Bernadette's groups.

### **Secretary's Report:**

The minutes from the last PCCW were read. A motion to accept the minutes was made by T. Garner and 2<sup>nd</sup> by J. Spindler. All members agreed.

### **Treasurer's Report:**

The treasurer's report, from September 2020 to June 2021, was presented by Missy Weiss. Our income from that time period was \$9667.64 and our expenses were \$10,141.97. Our ending balance was \$22,062.99. A motion to accept the treasurer's reports was made by J. Spindler and 2<sup>nd</sup> by M. Riebe. All members agreed.

### **New Business:**

#### Scholarship

Tiffany announced that this year's scholarship was given to Zack Weber.

#### Steubenville Donation

All members agreed that the PCCW would donate \$500 per year to this event. This would include \$500 for this year, 2021.

#### Swim Club Donation

Members of the PCCW decided to donate \$500 to the Durand Swim Club/Pool. We also, would sponsor a golf hole for \$100. (An event being sponsored by the Rolling Greens Golf Course).

#### Repair Request

S. Wolfe sent a request for money (\$10,650) from the PCCW to help defray costs for repair of the walls/steps to St. Mary's main entrance. After discussion, it was decided that more definite information/cost was needed before a monetary amount was given. This will be discussed again at our September meeting.

Fall Festival: Our festival is October 2nd. The PCCW was asked to provide a dinner. The decision was to have pulled pork sandwiches, hot dogs, chips, coleslaw, and a pickle. This could be sit down or take out. St Catherine and St Martha's groups will spearhead the dinner.

St Joan of Arc's group will provide desserts: bars, pies, cookies.

St Ann's group will be in charge of Tootsie Treasures.

Other events: games, Silent/Chinese auction will be discussed at September meeting.

#### Funeral Groups and Sacristans

Both D. Prissel and C. Prissel would like to resign as funeral group leaders .So we will need volunteers to assume these positions, as well as additional funeral helpers. Also, due to the fact that 2-3 sacristans have left, we have a need for them as well.

Hopefully, when Time and Talent sheets are handed out at church, we will get volunteers for funerals, sacristans, the church festival, etc. Also, when sending out information about the festival; the group leaders will include a letter stating the need for volunteers for various church jobs/positions.

#### Comments/Concerns

The PCCW will pay for the cost of cleaning the kitchen prior to the start of school.

It was suggested that a brief job description should be included for some of the positions at church.

Our next PCCW meeting will be September 1, 2021.
